

Headlines

- To make a headline stand out on the page, use `<h#> </h#>` (for "headline", where # = a number from 1 to 3).

Tag	How to use it	What it looks like
<code><h1> </h1></code>	<code><h1>Yada yada yada!</h1></code>	Yada yada yada!
<code><h2> </h2></code>	<code><h2>Yada yada yada!</h2></code>	Yada yada yada!
<code><h3> </h3></code>	<code><h3>Yada yada yada!</h3></code>	Yada yada yada!

Emphasize Words Using Bold, Italic, and/or Underline

- To make a word or phrase bold, use ` ` (for "bold").
- To make a word or phrase italic, use ` ` (for "italic").
- To make a word or phrase underlined, use `<u> </u>` (for "underline").

Tag	How to use it	What it looks like
<code> </code>	I'm a <code>bold</code> word.	I'm a bold word.
<code> </code>	I'm an <code>italic</code> word.	I'm an <i>italic</i> word.
<code><u> </u></code>	I'm an <code><u>underlined</u></code> word.	I'm an <u>underlined</u> word.
Mix 'n Match	I'm <code><u>all three</u>!</code>	I'm <i><u>all three!</u></i>

Emphasize Words Using Different Sizes

- To make a word or phrase a different size, use ` ` (where X = a number).

Tag	How to use it	What it looks like
<code> </code>	I'm a <code>size of 1</code> .	I'm a size of 1.
<code> </code>	I'm a <code>size of 2</code> .	I'm a size of 2.
<code> </code>	I'm a <code>size of 3</code> .	I'm a size of 3.
<code> </code>	I'm a <code>size of 4</code> .	I'm a size of 4.

Emphasize Words Using Color

- To make a word or phrase colored, use ` ` (where X = a color).
- Aqua, black, blue, brown, fuchsia, gray, green, lime, maroon, navy, olive, orange, purple, red, silver, teal, yellow or white.

Tag	How to use it	What it looks like
<code> </code>	I'm a <code>green</code> word.	I'm a green word.
<code> </code>	I'm a <code>blue</code> word.	I'm a blue word.

Horizontal Lines

- To draw a line across the screen, use `<hr />` (for "horizontal rule").

Tag	How to use it	What it looks like
<code><hr /></code>	Yada yada yada... <code><hr /></code> Blah blah blah...	Yada yada yada... <hr/> Blah blah blah...

Center Your Text

- To make a word or phrase centered on the page, use `<center> </center>`.

Tag	How to use it	What it looks like
<code><center> </center></code>	<code><center>Yada!</center></code>	Yada!

Create Lists with Bullets or Numbers

- Begin your list with `` for an ordered, or numbered, list and end the list with ``.
- Start the list with `` for an unordered, or bulleted list and end the list with ``.
- Each item in the list should have an `` tag at the beginning and an `` at the end.

Tag	How to use it	What it looks like
<code> </code>	My list: <code></code> <code>Yada yada yad</code> <code>Blah blah blah</code> <code></code>	My list: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Yada yada yada• Blah blah blah
<code> </code>	My list: <code></code> <code>Yada yada yada</code> <code>Blah blah blah</code> <code></code>	My list: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Yada yada yada2. Blah blah blah

Make Links

- To make a link to a web page, use ` ` (where url = the link location).
- To make a link to an email, use ` ` (where email = the email address).

Tag	How to use it	What it looks like
<code> </code>	<code>Click here</code> to visit our site.	Visit our site.
<code> </code>	Send me <code>Email</code> .	Send me Email .
